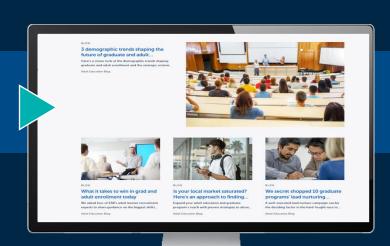

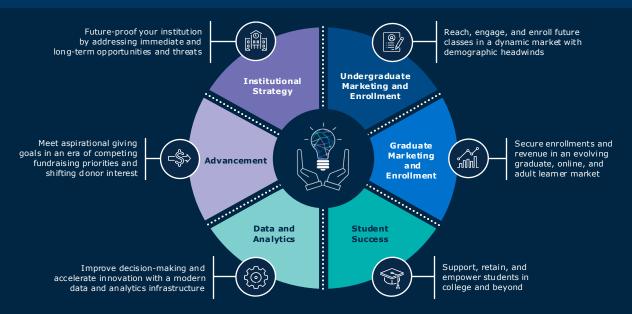

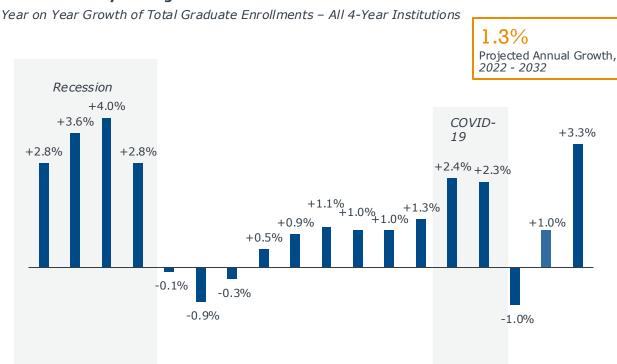

#### Are We Already Seeing Recession-Like Graduate Enrollment Growth?

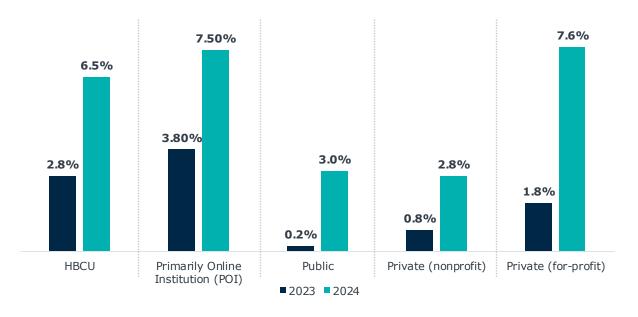

International students accounted for more than 50% of total grad student population at **5** of the top 10 institutions.



### **Highly Online**

4 of the top 10 institutions enroll more than 90% of their graduate students online.

#### **Best of Both Worlds**

In Fall 2023, 41% of IWU's graduate students were international, and 58% were online.

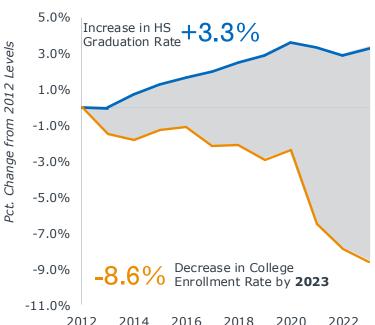

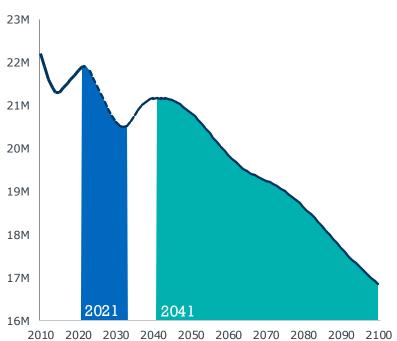

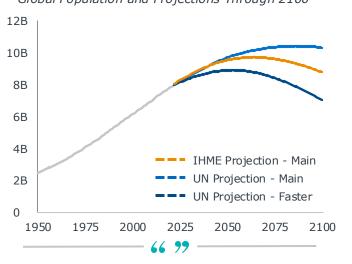

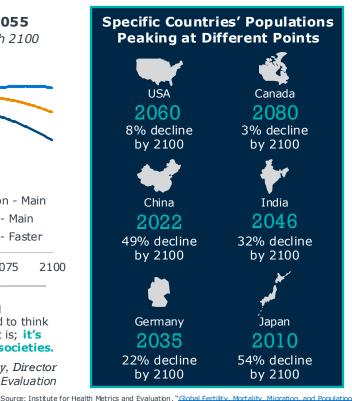

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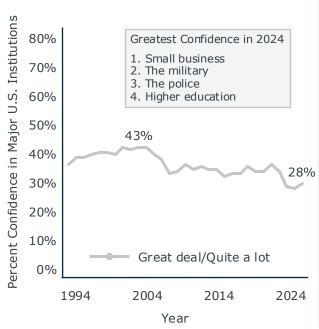

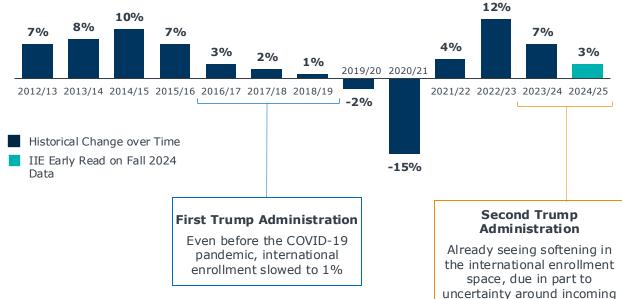

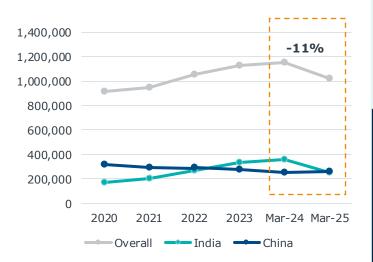

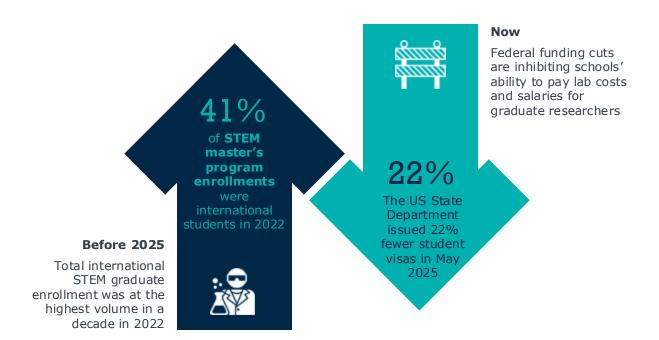

### A Declining Financial Outlook for the Sector





- Overall negative outlook
- · Recently downgraded from stable outlook due to federal policy changes

### **S&P Global**



- Overall bifurcated outlook
- Negative outlook for highly regional, less selective schools lacking financial flexibility

#### Fitch



- Overall deteriorating outlook
- Enrollment issues, tight margins, legislative uncertainty will erode budget flexibility

#### Positive Outlook

- 4% of ratings have positive outlooks1
- More positive outlook revisions and upgrades have occurred at higher end of ratings scale

### The Growing Credit Quality Divide

Hollowing Out of the Middle Percentage Point Change, 2015-2024

### Negative Outlook

- 12% of ratings have negative outlooks1
- 3:1 unfavorable to favorable revisions
- · Most downgrades in 2025 will be at lower end of ratings scale

### Student Loans and Aid



- Grad PLUS eliminated
- Parent PLUS capped
- SAVE repayment plan eliminated
- Hardship provisions removed
- "Workforce Pell" established

#### Immigration and International Enrollment



- Social media screening for visas
- 6000+ student visas revoked
- ICE raids now allowed on campuses
- Some local police deputized as immigration agents

#### Research Enterprise Funding



- 4000+ research grants cancelled
- 15% cap on indirect costs attempted by five agencies
- NIH Forward funding policy implemented
- Political appointees reviewing grant applications

## Accreditation and Accountability



- Accreditation transition streamlined
- Program-level earnings accountability tests

## Campus Climate and Culture



- Race-based practices categorized as illegal DEI
- Anti-Semitism task force formed
- Title XI rules reverted to 2019 standards
- 100+ civil rights investigations initiated

### Financial Leverage



### **Trump Policies Threaten All Major University Revenue Sources**

### **Undergraduate Tuition**

- · Reduce the max Pell Grant award
- Eliminate certain aid programs for low-income students
- Restrict lifetime borrowing for Parent PLUS loans
- Place earnings accountability on Title IV eligibility
- Expand Workforce Pell

#### **Graduate Tuition**

- Cap federal loan limits for graduate/professional programs
- · Eliminate Grad PLUS loan programs
- Tighten graduate program accreditation requirements
- Place an earnings test on loan access for programs

#### **International Students**

- Tighten visa screening and vetting
- Introduce a one-strike "catch and revoke" policy
- · Re-introduce travel bans
- · Propose a change to visas with fixed-term lengths

### **Research Funding**

- Cancel grants related to DEI
- Cap indirect cost recovery
- Reduce funding for science agencies
- Expand foreign gift reporting requirement

### **Philanthropy**

- · Increase endowment taxes
- Threaten non-profit status
- Restrict foreign gifts
- Enforce anti-boycott legislation affecting investments

### Goodbye to Grad PLUS Loans



#### **Key Changes**

Effective July 1, 2026

- Loans for graduate students capped at \$100k total, on top of undergraduate borrowing
- Loans for professional students capped at \$200k total\*
- Current students who have already received a Grad PLUS loan will have access to the loan for up to three more academic years

#### Likely Impacts of the Elimination of Grad PLUS



#### Less Access to Federal Aid

Students will be forced to turn to private loans without Grad PLUS



#### **More Students Opting Out**

Attending graduate or professional school may become untenable for some students, leading to lower enrollment and impacting universities' bottom line

## Scenarios for the Impact of Changes in Grad Lending:



#### **Programs Maintain Tuition**

- Students turn to private lending with higher interest rates
- Fewer families eligible, as private lending carries stricter credit requirements
- Access reduced; graduate enrollment limited to those with means
- Overall grad enrollment declines with narrowed access



#### **Programs Reduce Tuition**

- Institutions able to reduce tuition closer to caps may attract more students
- Programs already operating below caps have competitive advantage to start

#### Work is Changing Rapidly



Today's workers have not just **12-30 jobs** over a lifetime, but **multiple careers** as well



40% of job skills likely to be disrupted by 2027



Half-life of job skills keeps shortening, most requiring refresh every 5 years



Conventional pathways are necessary, but too slow for workers to stay current

## But Today's Adult Learning Not Meeting the Moment



Workplace PD invests in immediate productivity, not long-term growth



**Gig workers on their own** for continuous learning



No consensus on how to validate learning outside conventional models



Just-in-time content **teaches specific skills but lacks context**, reinforces blind spots

### **Demographic Decline**

Population decline, coupled with growing non-consumption among audiences who *could* enroll, will make it more difficult to find and enroll students



#### **Crisis of Confidence**

Concerns about higher ed's value further undermines future enrollment potential



#### **International Market Shuffle**

Policy changes may further inhibit enrollment from once large prospective student pools in China, India, and more



### **Shifting Revenue**

Declining international enrollment and limits to graduate financial aid will increase the need to effectively leverage aid dollars
