How One School's Peer-to-Peer Network Improved Yield Results for Admitted Students

A small, private, four-year institution located in Florida

CHALLENGE:

This university was in search of a solution that would provide admitted students with a place to learn more about their school and engage with their peers—both student ambassadors and fellow admitted students. Additionally, this school wanted to implement additional support on melt reduction and to increase yield.

SOLUTION:

This school partnered with **EAB's Wisr Virtual Communities** to create an "Admitted Students Network" and empowered their student ambassadors to proactively connect with admitted students through one-on-one outreach. Each week, their student ambassadors had dedicated time to engage with discussion posts, especially those that aligned with the school's messaging and priority areas. Much of this work was applied in the summer months as a melt mitigation strategy.



IMPACT:

As of July 2022, this partner experienced a reduction in summer melt in comparison to the previous year. Additionally, joining a virtual community had a positive impact on an admitted student's likelihood to deposit.


